1. Are all trips to be Medicaid eligible NET services? If so, who verifies eligibility?

2. What is the “no show” policy? What can be billed for “no shows”?

3. The RFP says that PCT will contact the contractor “when needed”. How much lead time will be provided, Does PCT currently have a supplemental provider?

4. Will the contractor be used for “in-county” trips or only for “out-of-county” trips?

5. Does the contractor have the option of declining a trip?

6. Section 1.4. A.2. of the RFP requires a “criminal background check”. Is this for the contractor, officers, all drivers? Is there a specific “type” of background check that is required? Please clarify.

Drivers will be responsible for completing a BCI background check.
