



As the Covid-19 pandemic continues to develop, Perry County Transit (PCT) stands with our community, customers and staff as we work together to continue essential transportation. The safety of our passengers, staff and community, is our highest priority. As recommended by the Centers for Disease Control, (CDC) we have instituted an additional layer of sanitation protocol to ensure the safest environment possible for passengers and staff and to work to prevent spread. In addition to our already aggressive disinfecting process, we are practicing social distancing by limiting the number of passengers in vehicles and advising passengers to be seated a minimum of two seats from the driver.

It is Perry County Transit's intent to continue providing critical transportation services to our customers during this National Emergency. For the immediate future, PCT is suspending some services in an attempt to maximize resources. PCT is focusing on three key transportation service areas. Prioritizing essential transportation related to Medical, Nutritional and Employment needs. To further assist with prioritization of services, beginning Monday March 23, 2020, PCT will temporarily suspend Wednesday hours, 6:00PM-9:00PM and all Saturday hours. Core operating hours of 6:00AM-6:00PM, Monday through Friday will be maintained for the identified essential transportation. Prioritizing essential Medical/Nutritional/Employment transports allows concentration of resources on the most critical needs and complies with the directive of Governor DeWine.

PCT is your transportation partner, we understand the constraints stemming from the COVID-19 pandemic. In both a gesture of understanding and for the safety of passengers and staff, all self-pay fares have been suspended for the duration of this National Emergency. Effective immediately, self-pay customers utilizing medical, nutritional or employment transportation will ride for free. As your mobility and transportation partner, it is our hope that the measures we have taken will be of help during this difficult time.
